Last mediation session was on Tuesday, February 12. Mediator stated that she will certify fact finding. Union did not agree on changing any health insurance. LABBB contribution is 82.5% and proposed an HRA plan by BCBS. LABBB offered 50% towards the savings to go into salaries. LABBB is only obligated to give 25% under 32B.

LCEA final proposal was for 2% in FY12, and 3% in FY13 with no change in Health insurance.

LABBB proposed all employees to be 11 month employees. Currently 75% of LABBB employees work 11 months. LABBB needs coverage for the summer to offer more consistency.

LABBB will vote to adopt 32B sections 21-23 at a future board meeting

Executive Director will also speak to EDCO Collaborative Executive Director to discuss EDCO using the space at Northeastern for their Central Office.
