Collaborative News:

• Dr. Kathleen Bodie asked if the School Committee's receive a Special Olympics invitation. She then asked if the Special Olympics invitation could be emailed to her electronically.

Discussion Items:

Flexible Spending Account (FSA): As of July 1, 2014 LABBB would like implement an FSA plan
from Benefit Strategies. The set-up fee for LABBB would be approximately \$300-400;
employees would pay approximately \$4.00 fee per month and LABBB would pay annual fee of
approximately \$400. Motion by Dr. Thomas Kingston to implement Flexible Spending Account.

Draft of FY15 Budget:

The first draft of the LABBB FY15 budget was presented. Overall increase in budget from FY14 is 2.3%.

- o 2% salary increase for unit A (professional) and unit B (paraprofessional) staff.
- o Projected 8.0% in increase in health insurance
- o In FY15 we will project for 311 students.

The LABBB board of directors is concerned about the 8% increase on health insurance considering we just transferred to a new plan. Due to this significant increase the board would like to consider the GIC. LABBB districts in the GIC had a 1% increase FY15. Executive Director stated that the union has asked LABBB why we have not considered the GIC.

Update LABBB / EDCO Building:

- Dr. Thomas Kingston made a motion to authorize a Financial Service Agreement not to exceed \$380,000 with EDCO Collaborative for one year. Executive director will continue dialogue with EDCO regarding space use by LABBB in the new building.
