Discussion Items

- Member Credits & Circuit Breaker
 - Scheduling a separate meeting with the District's Finance team to discuss this item.
 - DESE to include tuition to be paid through Member Credits
 - Individual student tuition under Circuit Breaker Threshold
 - Transportation piece internal vans within district can't file for services, External students qualify for service
 - Each district can use member credits, however possibly change tuitions to be less
 - Structure Rental fees this year would be a tough situation

Space for 2022-23

- o Middle School space concern for next year FY23
- Arlington to maintain a space Liz will follow up
- Lexington no space
- Belmont possible extra space
- Present program Francis Wyman aging out, they will need to go to a middle school
- o Arlington added a full cluster this year enrollment growth

Current Enrollments

- FY22 Run off forecast, currently developing
- September 286 students, down 11 students, \$600,000. Shortfall on budget
- Loss of staffing
 - 2-5% usually
 - 12-13% this year lost 50 staff personnel
 - Down 5 right now overall okay
- Operating Budget
- Cumulative Surplus Equity returning earning after the years
 - Dip into prior years not member districts
 - Maintaining 25%
 - Won't affect our budget because of districts

Employee Vaccinations

- LABBB put in place that all employees to be vaccinated by 10/1/21 or to provide letter of Medial or Religious exemption
 - 220 employees all vaccinated but 11 that provided a letter of exemption/ no resignations
- o Lexington down to 40 A,C,D out of 1300
- Bedford haven't touched it yet working with union
- o Belmont 98% vaccinated
- Arlington 98% response, 30% exemption letters
 - Can take sick days then unpaid leave until vaccinated
- Burlington Settlement on MOA/ probably will be at 98%

- o Provided 3 Staff Forums & 2 Parent Forums
- Creating a Voluntary screening committee
- Creating Position Profile
- Finalist go to Board
- Creative ways to network posting for diverse candidates
