It is very important to look at the pick up times, before signing up for an activity, to make sure that students will be able to be picked up on time.

Please make sure to alert your cab drivers when your student is not going home with them at the end of the day. We have had students leave on their cabs when they should be staying for an after school activity.

When the forms are sent, please e-mail me so that I will look for them to come in the mail or with the student. Forms have been known to get lost or not get to me so if you e-mail me, I will know to be looking for them. When I get the forms, I will e-mail back to confirm that I received them. If you do not get a response from me then I have not received the forms.
